

Beck Architecture and Whitespace Interiors collaborated to refresh the iconic Four Seasons Hotel in downtown Austin. The upgrades to the luxury hotel involved extensive renovations throughout the property, including the building exterior, conference spaces and the complete guest tower. The enhanced entry sequence provides a more pleasing visitor arrival experience, featuring an updated porte cochere, wider valet and parking lanes, new signage and custom oversized steel and glass entry doors. The exterior walls of the hotel received new paint in a muted, contemporary palette. The 18,000 SF of ballroom, prefunction, circulation and meeting spaces received a sophisticated palette of gray and white, along with upgrades to accessibility, lighting and audio visual capabilities. Extensive renovations inside the guest tower included all 298 guestrooms and suites, corridors and elevator lobbies. The renovations created a new category of double-bay luxury suites that immediately became popular and generate additional revenue.

Turner Construction is about to begin building enhancements and a modern refresh to approximately 22,000sf of public spaces of the Four Seasons Austin, scope includes refreshing Trio Restaurant, new meeting and board rooms, a fully updated lobby, and a new lakeside deck/patio that will be added as an extension to the existing bar and serve as a connection to the hotel's connection to Lady Bird Lake.
